

Peach Starts 2017 Winter sales for All Routes!

- **Subjected routes: All routes, both domestic and international**
- **Subjected boarding period: October 29, 2017 (Sun) – March 24, 2018 (Sat)**
- **Start date for sales: August 22 (Tue) 15:00**

As of today, August 22 (Tue), Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) has begun sales of flight tickets for its 2017 winter timetable (October 29, 2017 – March 24, 2018).

Sales will be underway for all Peach flights, both domestic and international.

Peach currently flies a total of 25 routes—12 domestic and 13 international. It will start servicing new routes from Sendai, Sapporo (Shin-Chitose), Fukuoka, and Taipei (Taoyuan) on September 24 (Sun) to further expand the Peach network.

Peach will continue to expand its routes to deliver happy, casual air travel.

<Items to note>

- The fares indicated on the following page are for “Simple Peach” one-way travel (including consumption tax).
- Peach does not charge a fuel surcharge.
- Handling charges, airport taxes, and other such fees are not included in the fares.
- Separate charges will be incurred for seat designations and checked baggage.
- A separate booking fee will be incurred when seats are purchased at the Contact Center or at an airport check-in counter.
- Fares may change depending on availability. The effective fare at the time of purchase will be applicable.
- Changes or additions may be made to fares and conditions without prior notice.
- Ticket sales are for some flights only.
- Ticket availability is subject to approval by the relevant authorities.

About Peach (www.flypeach.com)

Peach began its services in March 2012 with Kansai Airport as its hub. It established Naha Airport as a secondary hub in July 2014 and began servicing Haneda Airport in August 2015. More than 13,000 passengers currently fly Peach each day as it operates more than 90 daily flights, servicing 12 domestic and 13 international routes with its 19 aircraft. Peach is planning to set up a hub at Sendai Airport in September 2017 and at Shin-Chitose Airport in FY 2018.
