

## Peach Announces Status of Seat Reservations for Year-End and New Year Period FY 2017

**Osaka 22 December, 2017** - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) announced today the status of seat reservations for the FY 2017 year-end and New Year period (December 28, 2017 – January 3, 2018).

### 3) Overview of Reservations

Reservations are steady overall for domestic and international routes combined at a rate of 103.2 percent against a 102.3-percent seat availability rate compared to a year earlier.

Domestic reservations are particularly favorable in the Kyushu area while many bookings have already been received for overseas routes to South Korea, Taiwan, and China. December 28 will be the peak day for outbound domestic routes while December 29 will be the peak day for inbound routes. For international routes, the peak days are December 29 for outbound and December 30 for inbound routes.

Peach began its services in March 2012 with Kansai Airport as its hub. It established Naha Airport in July 2014 and Sendai Airport in September 2017 as secondary hubs. It currently flies 20 aircraft on 14 domestic and 14 international routes, operating a maximum of more than 100 flights daily and servicing more than 13,000 passengers. Peach is planning to open a route between Osaka (Kansai) and Niigata on March 1, 2018 and will also be setting up Shin-Chitose Airport as a hub during FY 2018.
