



Seat Sales to Begin for Summer Flights in 2018! Enjoy more happy sky travels with Peach in 2018

- **Domestic routes: Osaka (Kansai) and Sapporo (Shin-Chitose), Sendai, Niigata, Tokyo (Narita), Fukuoka, Kagoshima, Ishigaki; Tokyo (Narita) – Fukuoka; Okinawa (Naha) - Fukuoka**
- **International routes: All routes**
- **Boarding period: March 25, 2018 (Sun) – October 27, 2018 (Sat)**
- **Commencement of sales: 3 p.m. Dec. 25, 2017 (Mon)**

Osaka 25 December, 2017 - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) has started seat sales for flights during its 2018 summer schedule (March 25, 2018 – October 27, 2018).

Sales will begin at 3 p.m. today for some domestic routes and flights. Seats are available for sale on all international routes as of December 20 (Wed).

Peach currently operates 28 routes—14 domestic and 14 international—in total. It will open an Osaka (Kansai) – Niigata route on March 1, 2018 and an Osaka (Kansai) – Kushiro route on August 1 and further expand the Peach network in 2018.

- The fares indicated on the following page are for Simple Peach one-way travel (including consumption tax).
- Peach does not charge a fuel surcharge.
- Handling charges, airport taxes, and other such fees are not included in the fares.
- Separate charges will be incurred for seat designations and checked baggage.
- A separate booking fee will be incurred when seats are purchased at the Contact Center or at an airport check-in counter.
- Fares may change depending on availability. The effective fare at the time of purchase will be applicable.
- Changes or additions may be made to fares and conditions without prior notice.
- Seat sales are only applicable for some flights.
- Availability is subject to submission to and approval by the relevant authorities.

About Peach (www.flypeach.com)

Peach began its services in March 2012 with Kansai Airport as its hub. It established Naha Airport in July 2014 and Sendai Airport in September 2017 as secondary hubs. It currently flies 20 aircraft on 14 domestic and 14 international routes, operating a maximum of more than 100 flights daily and servicing more than 13,000 passengers. Peach is planning to open a route between Osaka (Kansai) and Niigata on March 1, 2018 and will also be setting up Shin-Chitose Airport as a hub during FY 2018.
