

Peach Announces Status of Reservations for 2018 Golden Week Vacation Period

Osaka 20 April, 2018 - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) today announced the status of reservations for the 2018 Golden Week period (April 27- May 6).

3) Overview

<Domestic Routes>

Peak travel day: April 28 for outbound and inbound.

Reservations for flights bound for the Hokkaido and Okinawa area have been particularly strong, with some flights already almost fully booked. Osaka (Kansai) - Nigata flights which was launched March 1 of this year are favorable as well. Extra flights are also planned to be operated between Osaka (Kansai) and Ishigaki (one round-trip) on May 3 and May 6, and Osaka (Kansai) and Okinawa(Naha) (one round-trip) on May 5 and May 6.

<International Routes>

Peak travel day: Apr. 29 for outbound, May 6 for inbound.

Reservations for flights bound for Taiwan have been particularly strong. Starting on April 26 will be offering a daily flight from Okinawa (Naha) and Kaohsiung. Extra flights are also planned to be operated between Osaka (Kansai) and Seoul (Incheon; one round-trip) on May 5 and May 7.

Seats may still be available on some flights, depending on the date. Reservations may be made on the Peach website at www.flypeach.com. Seat availability may also be checked on the Peach website, where information is updated daily.

About Peach (www.flypeach.com)

Peach began its operations out of its Kansai Airport hub in March 2012. It set up secondary hubs to follow Kansai Airport at Naha Airport in July 2014 and at Sendai Airport in September 2017. Peach currently has a fleet of 20 aircraft and operates more than 100 flights daily, serving more than 13,000 passengers on 15 domestic and 14 international routes. In addition to opening an Okinawa (Naha) – Kaohsiung route on April 26, 2018 and Osaka (Kansai) – Kushiro route on August 1, it is also planning to set up Shin-Chitose Airport as a hub during FY 2018.
