

## Launch of Service on Sapporo (New Chitose)–Soul (Incheon) Route — International Route Tickets for 2019 Summer Season to Go on Sale—

- Daily flights to be introduced on Sapporo (New Chitose)–Soul (Incheon) route starting April 25, 2019
- Daily flights to be introduced on Okinawa (Naha)–Hong Kong route starting June 28, 2019
- Daily flights to be introduced on the Tokyo (Narita) – Amami Oshima route starting October 1, 2019
- Two round-trip flights a day on Narita–Okinawa (Naha) route starting June 28, 2019
- Maximim Six round-trip flights a day on Narita–Sapporo (New Chitose) route starting September 1, 2019

**Osaka, December 17, 2018** - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”, President & CEO: Shinichi Inoue) announced today’s new route, the Sapporo (New Chitose)–Seoul (Incheon) route. Service on the new route will commence April 25, 2019. Peach announced the launch of its Tokyo (Narita) – Amami Oshima route starting October 1, 2019.

Peach will also relaunch service on the Okinawa (Naha)–Hong Kong, Tokyo (Narita)–Okinawa (Naha), and Tokyo (Narita)–Sapporo (New Chitose) routes.

Peach will introduce daily flights on the Sapporo (New Chitose)–Soul (Incheon) route starting April 25, 2019. In addition to being Peach’s second international route originating from New Chitose Airport, after Taipei (Taoyuan), the route will be the first one for a Japanese airline company.

Service on the Okinawa (Naha)–Hong Kong route was suspended on October 29, 2017, but daily service will be relaunched June 28, 2019. This will increase the number of Peach’s international routes originating from Okinawa (Naha) to five, which also include Taipei (Taoyuan), Kaohsiung, Seoul (Incheon), and Bangkok (Suvarnabhumi).

Details of the schedule, fares, and date that tickets go on sale will be advised later.

President & CEO Shinichi Inoue offered the following comment. “Peach will make the New Chitose Airport the gateway to North Asia by linking Hokkaido to Seoul. By relaunching service and introducing daily flights on the Okinawa (Naha)–Hong Kong route and introducing daily flights on the Sapporo (New Chitose)–Taipei (Taoyuan) and Sendai–Taipei (Taoyuan) routes, we have also created a schedule that makes it easier for Asian customers to visit Japan. Peach will strive to become the bridge to Asia by creating a broad network that links the various regions of Japan, from the North to the South.”

We will launch a new Tokyo (Narita) – on October 1, 2019 with one round trip per day.

Service on the Tokyo (Narita)–Okinawa (Naha) route was suspended on March 26, 2017, but will be relaunched on June 1, 2019. There will be two round-trip flights each day.

Service on the Tokyo (Narita)–Sapporo (New Chitose) route was suspended on March 26, 2017, but will be relaunched on September 1, 2019. At first, there will be six round-trip flights each day. This will result in a total of five routes originating from Tokyo (Narita), which include routes to Osaka (Kansai) and Fukuoka.

Details of the schedule, fares, and date that tickets go on sale will be advised later.

#### Summer Season Tickets to Go on Sale

International route tickets for the 2019 summer season (March 31–October 26, 2019) will go on sale December 18 (Tuesday).

Only tickets for some international routes, flights, and part of the summer season will be go on sale.

#### <Special notes>

- The fares on the following page refer to a single Simple Peach fare (including consumption tax) per seat.
- No fuel surcharges are levied on the customer.
- Customers must also pay other separate fees, including payment fee and airport usage fee.
- There is a separate fee for check-in baggage and seat reservations.
- A separate booking fee is charged when tickets are purchased at the Contact Center or airport counter.
- Fares depend on seat availability, and the fare at time of purchase is applicable.
- Fares and usage conditions may change or be added without prior notice.
- Only tickets for certain flights will go on sale.
- The flight schedule and fares are premised on applying and approval to related authorities.

Peach Aviation began services based out of Kansai Airport in March 2012. It opened secondary hubs at Naha Airport in July 2014 and Sendai Airport in September 2017. It currently operates 21 aircraft on 16 domestic and 15 international routes, flying up to more than 100 flights daily and serving more than 13,000 passengers.
