

## Ticket Sales for Tokyo (Narita) – Ishigaki Route Start Today – Peach is the only airline to offer direct flights from Narita to Ishigaki in winter 2019! –

- **Tokyo (Narita) – Ishigaki route starts December 26 (Thurs.), from ¥7,590 one-way**
- **Osaka (Kansai) – Ishigaki route expanded to double daily**

Osaka August 26, 2019 - Peach Aviation Limited (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Shinichi Inoue) will launch ticket sales\* from its Tokyo (Narita) – Ishigaki route at 17:00 today.

Service from Tokyo (Narita) to Ishigaki will begin on Thursday, December 26 as the only regular direct flight from Narita Airport to Ishigaki Airport during winter 2019 (October 27, 2019 – March 28, 2020). The addition of this route will increase the number of domestic flights that Peach offers out of Narita Airport to six as of Thursday, December 26.

Additionally, Peach will increase service between Osaka (Kansai) and Ishigaki, a route which Peach was the first LCC to offer in June 2013, to two round-trip flights daily beginning on Thursday, December 26.

Peach CEO Shinichi Inoue says, “In recent years, the Yaeyama area has been gaining major attention from both Japan and abroad as one of Japan’s representative resort areas blessed with rich and beautiful nature. It is my hope that guests not only from Japan but from all over Asia will be able to easily visit the Yaeyama area using Peach’s substantial domestic and international route network.”

Going forward, Peach will continue to expand its network of “flying trains” within Japan and in various parts of Asia.
