

All Domestic Flights Resume Operations Today — Bridging your Sky While Taking Thorough Measures to Prevent Infection —

- **Taking thorough measures to prevent infection, and asking customers for their cooperation**
- **Starting today, operating in accordance with the business plan, with about 100 flights on 22 domestic routes per day**
- **Resuming operations of all domestic flights, roughly one month after having resumed operations on all domestic routes on June 19**

Osaka, July 22, 2020 - Peach Aviation Limited ("Peach"; Representative Director and CEO: Takeaki Mori) has resumed operations of all its domestic flights from today. The number of flights it will operate per day will be about 100 flights on 22 routes, in accordance with the business plan for domestic flights that it had formulated before the spread of COVID-19.



Due to the impact of COVID-19, Peach had reduced or suspended flights on some of its routes from March 2020. It started gradually resuming operations from June, and on June 19, resumed operations on all 22 of its domestic routes, while keeping the number of flights reduced for certain routes. Now today, roughly a month later, Peach has resumed operations of all flights on all its domestic routes.

Peach is taking thorough measures to prevent infection at airports and onboard, such as requiring staff to wear masks, gloves, and face shields, as well as disinfecting the cabin. It has also produced a video regarding ventilation in the cabin, by which air is replaced approximately every three minutes. The video is available to view on the official website.

In order to operate while preventing infection, Peach has also asked customers for their cooperation. This includes requesting to them measuring their temperatures at home before boarding, maintaining social distancing at the airport, wearing a mask and refraining from talking in the cabin, and taking thorough measures to prevent infection at their destinations.

From August 1 (Sat.) to August 31 (Mon.), Peach will increase the number of domestic flights for a total of 3,967 flights in operation, which exceeds the initial business plan of 3,270 flights.



Number of flights added is 572 flights on 12 routes. Further, from August 1 (Sat.), it will launch two new routes, from Tokyo (Narita) to Kushiro and Miyazaki.

Peach will contribute to Japan's socio-economic growth by bridging together numerous regions while taking thorough measures to prevent infection, around the theme of "Bridging your Sky."
