

## **Seven Months since Suspension of International Services! Partial Resumption of “Taipei (Taoyuan) Route”!**

**-Reconnecting Japan and Taiwan as the “Bridge to Asia”-**

- **Resumption of the Osaka (Kansai), Tokyo (Haneda/Narita) - Taipei (Taoyuan) route on October. 25**
- **Resumption of international flight operations about seven months since suspension of all international routes on March 20**
- **Contributing to communication between Japan and Taiwan, and economic revitalization by ensuring both infection control and mobility**
- **Tickets on sale starting at 4:00 p.m. today**

Osaka, Thursday, Sep. 10, 2020, Peach Aviation Ltd. (hereafter, Peach; Representative Director & CEO: Takeaki Mori) announced the resumption of three routes between Osaka (Kansai), Tokyo (Haneda/Narita) - Taipei (Taoyuan) with three flights a week for each routes starting Sunday, October 25. Flight tickets go on sale today at 4:00 p.m.



As part of our goal to be the “Bridge to Asia,” Peach has built up service of ten flights to Taiwan - the most of any of its international routes - since the route between Osaka (Kansai) and Taipei (Taoyuan) was first launched in October 2012, thus easing the passage of people, goods and circumstances.

Currently, in association with the reduced demand due to the increase in COVID-19 infections, operations between Tokyo (Haneda) and Taipei (Taoyuan) have been suspended since March 2, while operations between Osaka (Kansai), Tokyo (Narita) - Taipei (Taoyuan) were suspended on March 20, and all 17 international routes have been suspended since March 20. Japan and Taiwan will be reconnected for the first time in about seven months through this partial resumption of operations on the Taipei route.

From now, we will not only provide our casual transportation as a “flying train,” but also respond as a mode of public transportation, to the needs of who must travel, such as international students, business customers, and those wishing to visit their families, while ensuring safe and secure air travel by thoroughly implementing countermeasures against infection at airports and on-board.

In association with the restricted use of public transportation for passengers who arrive at Taipei Taoyuan International Airport, we plan to cooperate with a transportation company which provides customer with airport pick-ups and drop-offs services in Taipei City, to enhance support services during your stay.

Peach will continue to contribute to communication between Japan and Taiwan, and economic revitalization under the theme “Bridging your Sky”.
