

Tokyo (Narita) – Memanbetsu and Tokyo (Narita) – Oita Routes Launched!

-Memanbetsu Flight is an LCC First, Oita is Peach`s 6th Kyushu destination from Narita-

- **Daily flights starts February 10, 2021 to Memanbetsu and February 19, 2021 to Oita**
- **One-way fares start at ¥5,290 for Narita–Memanbetsu and, ¥5,790 for Narita–Oita**
- **Tickets on sale**
- **Affordable fares make it possible to travel anywhere from Narita at any time**

Peach Aviation (“Peach”; Representative Director and CEO: Takeaki Mori) announced today the daily flights between Tokyo (Narita) and Memanbetsu on February 10 and between Tokyo (Narita) and Oita on February 19. Flight tickets on sale start at ¥5,290 for Memanbetsu flights and ¥5,790 for Oita flights.



These new routes between Tokyo (Narita) and Memanbetsu and between Tokyo (Narita) and Oita will expand Peach’s network from Narita Airport to 14 routes (12 domestic and 2 international).

Peach CEO Takeaki Mori says, “With these new routes out of Tokyo (Narita) to Memanbetsu and Oita, we will now have 12 domestic routes in and out of Narita Airport. This is on par with the number of domestic routes in and out of Kansai Airport, giving us two major hubs. Peach’s mission is to continue to connect regions by stably providing affordable air travel with low fares, with a priority on COVID-19 infection countermeasures. We aim to provide “flying trains” for local people living in the Greater Tokyo Area and the area surrounding Narita Airport. By expanding our network from Narita, we believe to help to improve the value of Narita Airport. In addition, with a priority on infection countermeasures, such as our trial program that opens some of our domestic routes to customers after antigen testing through the end of this fiscal year, we will continue operations to fulfill our role as a public transportation provider and contribute to the revitalization of society under the theme of ‘Bridging Your Sky.’”

Furthermore, in October of this year, Peach moved to Terminal 1 in Narita Airport, which is directly connected to the train station, improving convenience for everyone living in the Greater Tokyo Area and the area around Narita Airport. Going forward, Peach will continue to expand its network out of Narita Airport and contribute to the revitalization of Japan’s economy.
